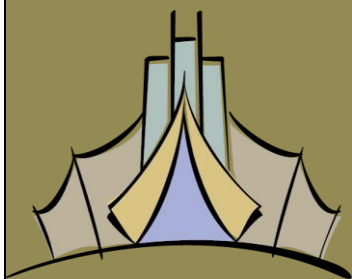

**A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR TROY**

Dear Church Family,

We have all watched in the last few weeks the rapid societal modifications associated with Coronavirus prevention. I think we are all surprised at how rapidly this virus has impacted the world. Uncertainty is definitely in the minds of many people.

In Bible times, the twelve disciples heard Jesus share with them some heavy news. Jesus told them He was leaving, that they would be persecuted, and that He would be left alone. He was referring to his arrest, trial and death, which was only a few hours into the future. But He also told them that their sorrow would be turned to joy. In John 16:33, Jesus to his disciples, "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

Regardless of how turbulent our lives are or become, God is still in control and He is immovable and completely reliable! Key to our peace is abiding in Christ.
