

VOLUNTEERS-REMINDER

We are so blessed to have over 230 volunteers, and we thank each of you for serving to expand God's kingdom! Our Idaho Conference has voted a NAD policy that all local volunteers be required to have background checks. We are already doing this with volunteers that work with children. This wider inclusion for all volunteers is an added measure for the safety of our children and, although requiring more involvement to maintain, is time and energy well spent. If you are renewing your screening (every three years), you may receive email reminders from ncsrisk directly. If you have completed this process for another Adventist group (volunteering at BVAS or GSAA or another SDA Church in the NAD) you do not need to complete the process again. Either add Cloverdale to your organizations, or let the church office know and we can ask the

conference office to search for your name (the system does not automatically find you).

The Cloverdale church will cover all costs associated with the screenings. If you have not yet completed the screening process, please go to: www.ncsrisk.org/adventist and follow the instructions.

If you are sitting at home with nothing else to do, now is the time to finish this task! Thank you to those who have taken the time to complete this process!

I talk with someone at the Social Security office today and they will never call asking for information. They will always mail you a letter asking you to call them. So, please, don't get duped in this mess and don't let your family members get sucked in.
