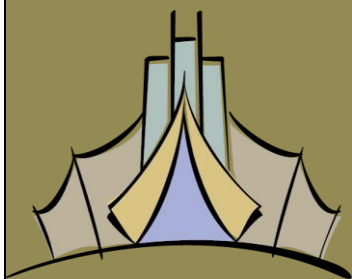

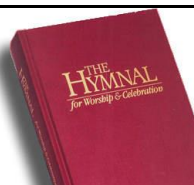
## **NORMA GIBBS**

**VOLUNTEERS—REMINDER!!!** The Idaho Conference has voted a NAD policy that all local volunteers be required to have background checks. We are already doing this with volunteers who work with children. This wider inclusion for all volunteers is an added measure for the safety of our children and, although requiring more involvement to maintain, is time and energy well spent. If you are renewing your screening (every three years), you may receive email reminders from ncsrisk directly (if you are over a year late, you may not receive these notices). If you have completed this process for another Adventist group (volunteering at BVAS or GSAA or another SDA Church in the NAD) you do not need to complete the process again. Either add Cloverdale to your organizations, or let the church office know and we can ask the conference office to search for your name (the system does not automatically find you).

## Our School Highlights . . .

**Enrollment:** Our school year has started with 60 students enjoying in-person school. There are 13 new students walking through our doorways, comprising 8 new families.

**New School Guidelines:** School looks a little different this year with temperature checks in the morning, desk cleaning at noon and desk sanitization after student dismissal. Masks are not worn when students are working at their desks, but are when they are walking around the classroom or hallways. Staff follow the same guidelines. Principal Utt has also been busy installing plexi-glass barriers in some areas. Though COVID initiated these new procedures, we anticipate a better school year due to their implementation, with an overall cleaner facility and healthier students and staff.

**God is Our Refuge** is this year's theme at BVAS along with Psalm 91:2. It is painted in the foyer, reiterated in the classrooms, focused on at Friday chapels, highlighted on the school t-shirt, and more. Pray for our students to learn how God is Our Refuge throughout the school year.

**Tuesday Pastor Worship:** Did you know that every Tuesday, pastors come into the classrooms to share worship thoughts with students? Pastor Jim Bollin from the Kuna SDA Church, Pastor Tomm Lemon from the Oasis SDA Church, Pastor Troy, and Pastor Jason rotate through each classroom every week. Students enjoy the variety of stories, testimonies, thoughts, discussion, etc., that each Pastor brings. Thanks to all of them for their commitment to BVAS.

**STEM:** STEM is a growing movement in schools and BVAS is a part of that. From grades K-8, our students are involved in engaging projects and activities focusing more on Science Technology Engineering & Math.
